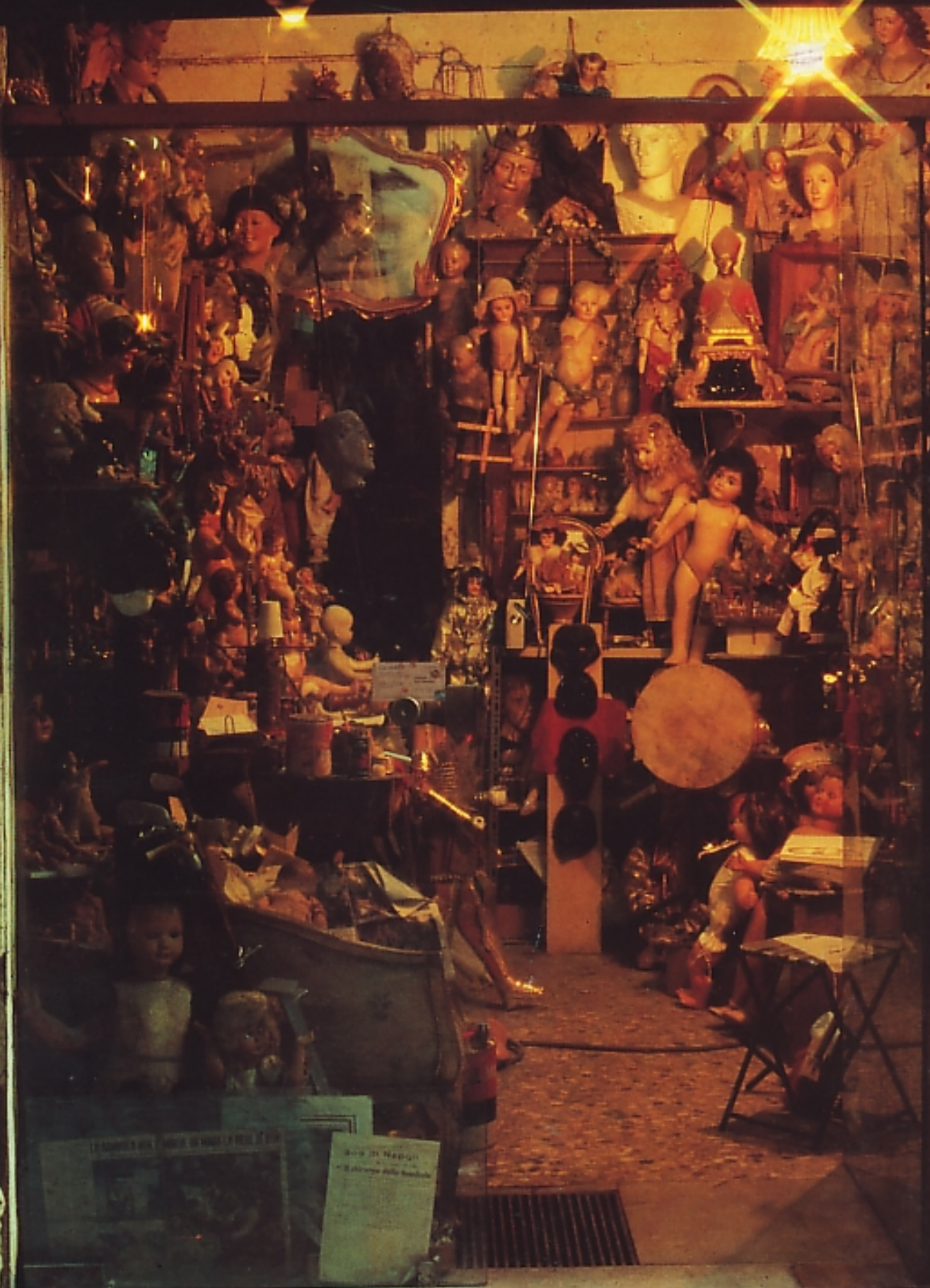


# On Healing Dolls and People
